If you're between 15 – 23 years old and you're deaf or hard of hearing, you could be awarded a fantastic Youth Grant. You could apply for up to **\$2,500** to fund a personal goal or group project which benefits your community, helps you to reach your potential and inspires others.

Funded projects have been based on:

- **Personal development** - Showing off creative talents, developing a skill or pursuing a passion eg joining a World Challenge trek
- **Deaf Community and Culture** - Learning more about the Deaf community in Australia or overseas eg attending national or international Deaf events
- **Leadership** – Developing leadership skills and becoming a positive role model for the wider community eg Establishing a riding school for other children and young people with disabilities
- **Education** – Accessing extra support with secondary or tertiary studies eg Funding for a deaf-friendly stethoscope for nursing
- **Life Experience** – Representing youth or deaf people at a conference or event, or playing for your state/country at any major sporting competition
